Location: Town Line Road, Roxbury

Description: Large fields and a wooded section that includes the Town Line Farm Trail. There is a historic home built in 1842 (called the Chauncey Beers house) as well as a large barn complex with two blue silos. The BWLT Office is located in the barn complex.

Of Note: This preserve has been leased to farmers for many years it is primarily used for hay and grazing cattle.
