First Memorial Bench Honors A Dog In Loving Memory Of Gumbo


The Bridgewater Land Trust has placed a memorial bench on Town Line Road in honor of a French Bulldog named Gumbo. Gumbo had been a part-time, then full-time resident of Bridgewater since 2017. He passed away in March at the age of thirteen. He was owned by Bridgewater residents Marc Rogers and Benjamin Probber.

Soon after Gumbo died, a friend of Marc and Ben's, Victoria Forrester, contacted the BWLT to ask if we would consider placing a memorial bench for Gumbo at the Jane Pratt Preserve on Town Line Road. She felt it would be a wonderful tribute to a dog they so adored. Victoria wanted to surprise Marc and Ben, who were unaware of their friend's act of kindness and generosity.

Julie Stuart, Executive Director of the BWLT, was caught by surprise with the request. "We had never done a memorial bench on any of our properties and did not have guidelines in place, but this was such a heartwarming sentiment that the staff and Board of Directors wanted to make it happen." The Land Trust was able to obtain the granite stones from the Mine Hill Quarry in Roxbury and worked with Burton's Monuments out of Waterbury to create the memorial plaque for the top of the bench. The plaque reads "For Gumbo, Forever Walking With Us."

Gumbo was adopted by Marc and Ben in 2011 when he was eight weeks old. He was the runt of the litter, and according to Marc his personality belied his small size. "He had a purposeful, larger than life personality. A Type A with a Napoleon complex." Ben added, "He actually loved people more than other dogs. People in Bridgewater began to know us through our dog."

Marc and Ben were so touched when Victoria unveiled the bench at the Jane Pratt Preserve. "Gumbo absolutely loved the open space in Litchfield County. The highlight of his day was seeing the cattle along Town Line Road." Marc said.


