

The Bridgewater Land Trust has received a piece of land from Bridgewater resident Jeanne Paparazzo. It is ideally located next to our new Tappen Brook Trails network on Tappen Road. It is bordered on both sides by Eversource land, all of which is leased to the BWLT in a long term and renewable agreement. The wooded parcel includes an old foundation and a tributary to Clapboard Oak Brook which feeds into Lake Lillinonah. See map below.




Moon Viewing
